PHASE ONE: CHILD

Re-examining the story we formulated during childhood that shaped who we are today, and exploring whether that same story continues to benefit us, or whether an entirely **new** story can bring us to a more wholesome and joyful place. We will also discuss historical female figures, the challenges they faced, and the stories they chose to live.

PHASE TWO: MAIDEN

For most of us, transition from child to maiden passes without any form of acknowledgement or celebration. In this workshop we will honor the feminine aspects of our bodies and our psyches, and ritually celebrate each of us.

PHASE THREE: MOTHER

Regardless of the gender we are born into, or whether or not we ever give birth to another human, we all have qualities of nurturing, comforting, healing, unconditional loving and nourishing for ourselves and for others.

In this workshop you will have the opportunity to examine what you most desire to give birth to for yourself at this stage of your life. Together, we will explore what parts of ourselves yearn to receive from a mother figure those very qualities innate in that role. You will be given tools with which to (1) better nurture yourself, (2) reach out to others for nurturance and support, and (3) open up the portals of connection to the ultimate Nurturance of the Great Mother. Once the self is nurtured, it is then easier for us to approach the question: "As a community of women, what are we wanting to collectively offer to one another and beyond?" We will explore this briefly in this workshop, then more deeply in the fourth and final one of the series.

PHASE FOUR: WISE WOMAN

Whether you are currently in the Child, Maiden, or Mother phase, there is a wise woman inside of you always! After all, the highest potential of the mighty oak tree lies within the deepest depths of the acorn. In virtually all of the ancient spirit traditions, Wise Woman is portrayed as the skillful weaver of transcendent wisdom and immanent pragmatism, gifting family and community with the insight of foresight and the lessons of hindsight. She offers clarity in the haziness of the obscure, and challenge to the smugness of complacency. She is no less Sister than she is Mother, and as much Friend as Mentor. In this workshop, you will have the opportunity to further explore the gifts and talents you have been given and that you have nurtured within yourself, and how you might tap deeper into the seeds of potential within you so that those potentials become more fully realized.
